Role

As **Head of Product Development – Biotech Medical Products**, you will be responsible for strategy-driven product development for the Group's global markets. You will guide plant-based active substance- and material concepts through structured development processes and manage projects from medical and technical feasibility assessments through CE marking and handover to production.

You combine scientific expertise with product knowledge, regulatory compliance, and systematic project management. You will report directly to the CEO and work closely with Regulatory Affairs, Quality Management, Production, Medical Management, and Product Management. Other key interfaces include surgeons, hospitals, scientific institutions, testing laboratories, and external development partners. The company combines in-house research and development expertise with short decision-making paths, industrial production, and an international market perspective. As part of a long-term succession plan, the position of Head of Product Development is now being filled.
